STALL REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

SATURDAY 17th SEPTEMBER 2022

We do wish to keep everyone safe at Barnstaple Carnival and so would ask you to abide by our 'Code of Conduct'.

Applications and Fees:

- The charges for spaces at this year's Stalls are as follows: £50 Foodie, £25 Other, £10 Charity.
- Applications for spaces must be submitted to the Carnival Committee by <u>28th August 2022</u>
- If your application is initially unsuccessful you will be included on the reserve list.
- A 50% non-returnable deposit of the total balance must be received on confirmation of pitch.
- If full payment has not been received by 4th September 2022 the space allocated will be let to an applicant on the Carnival Committee's reserve list.

Set up and Space:

- Stalls must not be brought onto the ground before carnival day.
- Any site not taken up by noon on Saturday (without prior arrangement with the Committee) will be re-let. No refund will be given in this instance
- Stalls etc. must be placed in the position allocated by the Carnival Committee. The right is reserved to remove any stall at any time should it be found necessary to do so.

- Any space allocated will be for the use of the applicant only. Sub-letting is not allowed. Any change of trade will invalidate the permit to stand.
- At the end of carnival day all stalls must leave the ground before 10pm.
- Upon leaving, the site must be left in a clean and tidy condition. Any soil or turf, which is removed, must be replaced. The condition in which the site is left will be taken into account when lettings are made in future years.

Waste and Refuse:

· Refuse must be left in bags for collection.

All Stalls:

- The Electricity at Work Regulations apply and all licensees will be required to produce, to the Council's Inspector when required, the relevant certificate regarding compliance with Section 6 Health and Safety at Work Act 1974. Current Certificates issued by the Amusement Device Inspection Procedure Scheme (ADIPS) and National Inspection Council (NIC) will be accepted.
- All licensees selling foodstuffs must comply with the current Food Hygiene Regulations.
- The sale of goods of a dangerous, obscene, or illegal nature is forbidden.

These simple rules are in place for the safety of all participants.
